“Cultivating the Presence of God”

A gathering of Kingdom Life Network leaders began with early prayer led by P. C. Alexander of PTL-India at 4:15 pm at Grace Chapel in Elizabethtown, PA. This kicked off the KLN Impact 2017 conference. Impact conferences are now every other year with "even" years dedicated to KLN Mission teams. The leaders took time to process and explore 10 core points around the theme of Vision & Priorities For Kingdom Life Network. Lawrence Chiles of Koinonia Fellowship of Churches asked the team to re-visit the original vision and does that vision keep us current for the next 5 or so years. Joseph Kamau of Happy Church in Kenya proposed continued intentional visitation of leadership teams to the varied networks each year or at least every other year. And he asked for key written articles to share with one another around pertinent issues. Henry Buckwalter of Harvest Fellowship of Churches also stressed continued strengthening of relationships within the networks.

Kingdom Life Network represents 8 networks of churches in the USA, India, Kenya, & Cambodia. All network leaders were represented except Cambodia. The 5:00 pm meal began the main conference. Joyce Shultz and staff served up the early registrants. The 7:00 pm main service began with lively worship led by Sonya Pena and team. E. Daniel Martin of the New Testament Fellowship network was the evening moderator

and encourager in releasing healing hands one to another. The evening keynote address was delivered by Kingdom Life Network President Henry Buckwalter. Leonard Burkholder of Anabaptist Native Fellowship of Churches introduced and prayed for Henry. Psa. 63 was read by HFC member Stacey Ann Gibson. Priorities, Purpose, Passion were the key points.

Henry shared recent story from a trip to Haiti. A great and strong unction came upon the team in a remote region to stop in the moment and to declare "Thy Kingdom come, Thy will be done" upon the region. By weeks end, the voodoo priest came and gave his heart to the Lord.

David sang and worshipped with passion in the midst of dire circumstances. Henry highlighted passionate worship leading by Sonya Pena despite her and husband's hour of trial regarding recent news of their child in the womb.
