### **“That I May Know Him”**

The third annual KLN Retreat kicked off with worship and a warm welcome by Mel Weaver, thankful that we are able to meet together and share what God is doing all over the world

Brother David Kandole got this word for the conference: "This week we are going to see overflowing, overwhelming, and overturning of the Spirit of God."

Another word for KLN was this: "God said, "Behold, I am going to make a covenant. Before all your people I will perform miracles which have not been produced in all the earth nor among any of the nations; and all the people among whom you live will see the working of the LORD, for it is a fearful thing that I am going to perform with you" (Exodus 34:10).

E Daniel shared a story that happened this morning when we went for a walk on the trail. He wanted to go down to the stream that he saw running alongside the trail. He figured he wanted to go get into the water but didn't see a way down to it. As he turned to go, stumbled, landed on his knees, and saw a path down to the stream. He walked down, and got into the water, refreshed. It was a

picture for him of the fact that we are not content to sit by and observe the stream, but we want to go get in.

Laura Viscome of Lifegate gave a word: Mark 12:41-44 "And Jesus sat down opposite the treasury and watched the people put money in the offering." (What an awkward thing for Jesus to do). The well-to-do gave out of their abundance, but the widow out of her poverty. Laura felt the Lord was saying, "The victories are sweet when we give them to Him and when we celebrate with Him. But when we lay down the disappointments, the broken stuff, the unpleasant things, the failures...they have a sweet aroma to Him."

We were introduced to Feet on the Street worship team. Feet on the Street (out of Reading, PA) will be performing a not-to-be missed production on the Book of Acts Saturday evening at 6 p.m. – lots of laughter and touching moments!)

Lawrence Chiles delivered the message. Among some great stories, he told of a friend who called him and wanted to spend two hours with him. This man asked Brother Chiles, "How can I become a better Christian? How can I go deeper?"

Brother Chiles spoke out of Philippians 3:10-14, "that I may know Him and the power of His resurrection and the fellowship of His sufferings, being conformed to His death; in order that I may attain to the resurrection from the dead.

Not that I have already obtained *it* or have already become perfect, but I press on so that I may lay hold of that for which also I was laid hold of by Christ Jesus. Brethren, I do not regard myself as having laid hold of *it* yet; but one thing *I do*: forgetting what *lies* behind and reaching forward to what *lies* ahead, I press on toward the goal for the prize of the upward call of God in Christ Jesus."

v. 12 "not that I have already attained this... "(Paul has been put under arrest by Christ). He/We want to

apprehend Christ the same way He has apprehended us. The first thing someone does who has been placed under arrest is raise his hands (surrender).

Knowing Christ is taking time to get to know Him. "Take your time." Anything that is worth anything takes time.

These four things Brother Chiles prayed would take root in our hearts:

A desire to know Him

A desire to become more like Him

A desire to forget the past

A desire to press on to the upward goal
