Acts 8:1-8 was the text read by Henry Buckwalter. Never can we change our society unless we as individuals change. We are called to change the

atmosphere where we work, where we serve. We are all called to full-time kingdom work ...no matter what our title may be. Our feet belong on the Rock.

A passionate call and command was given; "don't give up, don't turn back, don't turn away!" He encouraged us to follow God's will, not your own. He challenged us to withstand rejection. Jesus and even Paul, the greatest of missionaries, they both faced rejection. Kingdom transformation is to preach the Word, not ideas.

The encouraging story of a family man from Henry & Millie's home church was shared. 24 hour prayer came forth for this man, who had fallen two stories, hitting his head on a concrete ledge, in a coma ...yet he recovered. He defied odds, defied protocol, and recovered in such a very short time despite their saying he probably would never walk or talk again. God was glorified.
