Myra Robinson of Locust Lane church in Harrisburg was invited forward to offer her beautiful voice in song.

Lawrence Chiles challenged us to "be real". 2 Cor. 3:16-18 says we are being transformed. Let's not assume that we do not have veils. The prayer is that we are changing, we are different - hopefully for the better - than what we were 6 months ago.

Lori Baynard from the Koinonia Fellowship of Churches taught from Matt. 4:17. Jesus had a way about him that was not afraid to disrupt the church status quo. His calling drew him to places where others did not go. Jesus was not looking for the best pulpits in town but rather He went to minister to those at the town water wells, He hung out with those who collected money, and those that were misfits. This kingdom, this example, has now been entrusted to us!

The afternoon was packed with 6 varied sessions including topics of Transformational Prayer taught by David Kandole, Transformational Finance taught by Vard Gainor and Chinedum Uwaga, the Role of Ministry Wives and Women's Ministry taught by Lori Baynard, Celebrating Holy Sexuality in a Unholy Culture by E. Daniel Martin, and Transformational Technology by Mark Krieg.

Ex. 2 was the evening text read by P.C. Alexander. Moses' parents dared a different path ...they had a

vision for a deliverer. Vision causes us to choose a different path. Vision involves risk. Vision can outgrow us and it is hard to let go. The simple act of hiding baby Moses and trying to hide his cries turned into something bigger. They had to release Moses into the reeds and bullrushes ...and the vision was just begun.

David Kandole concluded the evening and shared his vision of coming from Uganda to America as a missionary some 20 years ago. He was dropped in inner-city Harrisburg and, for 3 years, had only 10 people. But they held fast in prayer and God changed the atmosphere. Mel Weaver sent them chairs and said "you can do it". And he did. LaShawn Walker's life was transformed and he came and he shared. He poured into a life of a former skin head named Sonny ...and he came and shared.

Mark 2 simply declares the Word was preached. The Word brings life, it brings hunger. Don't lose your hunger for God. It will keep you alive. Power is released to the hungry. The cake is baked for miracles when there is hunger, mixed with the Word, and faith is the active ingredient.

Wednesday and Thursday general offerings were \$280 and \$472 respectively.

A very special thanks to many that hosted families. Registered attendance was approx. 100 people for the day sessions with 60 children attending Camp Awake, many others joining for the evening sessions.
